
Purpose of Christian Faculty Network at TAMU


Is to provide a forum for philosophical and theological dialogue amongst the growing community of Christian faculty and spouses who wish to:


- Establish friendships with fellow seekers
- Facilitate integration of their Christian faith into their professional lives


Purpose statement continued






